

Child Safety Reporting

Reportable Incidents Include:

- A child sexual offence
- Sexual misconduct committed in relation to, or in the presence of a child
- Ill treatment of a child
- Significant neglect of a child
- Physical violence committed in relation to, or in the presence of a child
- Behaviour that causes significant emotional or psychological harm to a child

Who Should I Tell?

Any concerns should be reported to the club's President and Secretary.

What Happens Then?

They or their delegate(s) will:

- Within 3 business days contact and seek advice from the QFCC
- Commence an internal investigation if warranted and advised by the QFCC to do so
- Contact and offer support to the child and family involved

How Will I Know What's Happening?

The President and Secretary, or their delegates will keep the family of the child and the person who raised the matter informed about their progress and outcome of their investigation.

What's The Timeline?

The President and Secretary or their delegates will send a report of their investigation to the QFCC within 30 days of the notification.

QFCC WILL MAKE THE DECISION WHETHER TO TAKE THE MATTER FURTHER
